1. What Is Suicide?

GUOTE: "The word 'suicide' is without a doubt one of the most dreadful expressions in the English language. People wince at the sound of it and avoid using it to describe the tragic death it implies. Leprosy and cancer are spoken of in the same hushed tones. And yet it must be faced squarely and discussed openly because it has become one of the leading causes of death among both the young and the very old in this country. No one can be sure of the exact figures because suicides are deliberately misreported and misdiagnosed as an accident. My own personal experience with it is still a nightmare. The death of my nineteen-year-old daughter, Diane, after experimenting with LSD, changed my life and the lives of everyone in my family. We still find it difficult to understand or discuss."– Art Linkletter (1993)
