

Introduction:

Five misnomers about follow-up:

- 1. Follow-up is overrated or antiquated.
- 2. Everyone requires the same type of follow-up.
- 3. Follow-up must be confrontational or comprehensive.
- 4. If follow-up is not done a certain way it is wrong.
- 5. Follow-up follows a linear formula into which everyone fits.

Five aspects to all follow-up:

1. The Principle: _____ Follow-Up?

"And he saith unto them, Follow me, and I will make you fishers of men." (Matthew 4:19)

QUOTE: "The priority for every follow-up visit is to inspire and encourage someone to follow Christ."

"And he said unto them, How is it that ye sought me? wist ye not that I must be about my Father's business?" (Luke 2:49)

QUOTE: "Authenticity and honesty (aka unselfish motives) are what everyone craves from those within the church."



QUOTE: "Sometimes we are much better at pushing Jesus on people than being Jesus to people."

2. The Assessment: _____ to Follow-Up?
